

A heart of gold stopped beating 01-22-2008 Two beautiful eyes at rest. God broke my heart to prove, He only takes the best. God knows you had to leave me, but you did not go alone, for part of me went with you. the day he took you home. The house that you now respond is overstaffed with heroes who answered one last bell, did the job and did it well

Christa Dawn Burchett born at 10:05am weighted only 5lb 13oz a very tiny beautiful gift from God!

On the morning of **January 22, 2008, Christa** responded to a call for help from a young mother-to-be who had lost control of her car on an icy road. She rushed to the scene in an ambulance and was

helping the young woman to get into the ambulance. At the same moment a tractor-trailer loaded with coal began sliding on the highway and hit Christa and the mother-to-be. The mother was killed on impact. Christa died at Paul B. Hall Regional Medical Center in Paintsville at 10:04 a.m.

Christa's name and legacy will live on through the lives and people she has touched. Christa left too early and not a day goes by that her family and friends don't think of her and miss her dearly. Christa left behind a beautiful daughter Olivia Burchett (14), who had to grow up way to soon. Being left without a mother at such as young age, has changed her life forever.























































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































































I am strong because I did not choose drugs or alcohol to hide behind. Because, somehow, I managed to not get myself killed or die and found a way to reinvent myself. To try to move away in search of a pain free location that had no memories but only to find the same internal pain.

I chose to become the person you see today, the person that reminds you of the possibility of your worst fear, the same person who cherishes time with her living children and everyone she loves.

I am strong because I WAKE UP EVERY MORNING, I get dressed and I FACE the world one day at a time. Mainly I am strong because my beautiful daughter did lived, because with everything I lost, I have my memories to cherish, and my love that goes beyond the realm of death.

Because I have son and a Granddaughter who my Daughter left behind need me to be strong and my real friends who allow me to be weak. I am strong because I am loved.

Honor to our Fallen Hero

January 26, 2010

Christa Burchett. January 22, 2010 was the second anniversary of Christa's death. I'm sure you are aware of the circumstances of her passing. To honor our "Fallen Hero".

On 1/22/2010 a blood drive was held in Christa's honor. This was the third drive that was held in her honor. The first one was held six months after her death, and the following two where held on January 22, of 2009 and 2010. We plan on having blood drives each year as our way of ensuring that Christa's death is not in vain. During the blood drive we had 56 individuals sign up to give, with some giving Double Red. In total we collected 65 units of blood. Each unit of blood helps save 3 lives, that means Christa has made a difference to 195 people this year. In total we have collected enough blood to help 300 individuals, in the past two years in Christa's name. 

Flags to fly at half-staff Sunday to honor fallen firefighters

Flags at all state office buildings will be lowered to half-staff Sunday in observance of National Firefighters Memorial Day under an order from Gov. Steve Beshear. The observance honors U.S. firefighters who have died in the line of duty, including the 103 who died in 2008, according to a press release.

One of the firefighters who died last year was from Kentucky. Christa Burchett, 33, an assistant fire chief and EMS director with the Paintsville Fire, Rescue and EMS, died after being struck by a coal truck at the scene of an accident Jan. 22, 2008.

In a ceremony Sunday, a plaque with the 103 firefighters' names will be added to the National Fallen Firefighters Memorial at the National Fire Academy in Emmitsburg, Maryland

This is a store Chris wrote about when it was time for her baby girl to come into this world 05/06/2002; we came across it in some of her things thought we would share with you.

It was late in the evening on Jan. 30,1993 in Johnson County, KY. I was just returning from a trip into town, when I began to feel pain and pressure in my lower abdomen. I walked in and sat down on the couch to see if it would help relieve some of the pain. After a few hours of pain and pressure, I realized it must be contractions that I was feeling. I woke my husband and we began our trip to the hospital.

After arriving at the hospital in Ashland Ky it was confirmed by the doctors that I was in labor and would have a long journey ahead. The pain was beginning to become worse with each minute. I thought of how bad it felt to just lay there in the bed and not be able to do anything about the pain I was feeling. I tried walking, and sitting up in the bed, sitting on the edge of the bed, but nothing seemed to help.

My family had just begun to come in and fill the room when things began to go wrong. The nurse rushed to my side, and they begun to roll me from side to side. I didn't understand what was going on, or why they were doing this to me. All I knew was how worse it seemed to make my pain feel. I asked them to please

stop making me roll from side to side, but they instead I must keep rolling. Finally, they allowed me to stop rolling and proceeded to inform me of what was going on. They advised me that the baby had lost her heart beat, and they weren't sure what the problem was; therefore, by having me roll from side to side, it would allow them to be able to tell if she was holding on to her umbilical cord. And sure enough, she had grabbed a hold of her cord and didn't want to let go. After all the bouncing around it finally caused her to finally let go.

Needless to say, after 26 hours of excruciation pain, I finally delivered a beautiful, 8lb. 3oz., black hair, blue-eyed baby girl. It was a moment filled with excitation, happiness, and relief, because, it was finally all over.

I never thought that one person could possibly change my life as she has. There is never a dull moment, and she always brings a smile to my face. I love her with all my heart and could never imagine life without her. Regardless of all the pain and suffering with labor and the delivery, I would not change one thing.


